## Theme: The Journey to Divine Love

Abu Darda (RA) reported: The Messenger of Allah (SAW), peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Dawud would supplicate, saying: O Allah,. I ask you for your love and the love of those who love you and the deeds that will bring me your love. O Allah, make your love more beloved to me than myself and my family and even cold water."

(al-Tirmidhī 3490)

Allah, the most high, also mentions in a Hadith Qudsi:

"I Am Ar-Rahman. I created the Raham (womb) and derived a name for it from My Name. Hence, whoever keeps it (family ties), I will keep ties to him, and whoever severs it, I will sever ties with him."

(Bukhari 5988)

The word *Rahma* is often translated simply as Mercy; yet that translation is not completely accurate. As stated in a hadith Qudsi, Rahma is closely linked to Rahm (womb). Why did Allah (SWT) link these two words, and hence link His love to a mother's one? A mother's womb exemplifies Rahma's purest meaning. It represents a place of safety and care, where a being is conceived and given unselfish loving care.

Even more than a mother's love, He is constantly there for us, loving us, leading us, guarding us, and supporting our lives down to their most minute elements, even though we don't always recognize or even sense His presence.

Loving each other and loving Allah are deeply intertwined. It's not possible to have one without the other. Someone who loves Allah will also love their family, their surroundings, their friends, their siblings, other believers, and most importantly the Prophet (SAWS).

We must constantly look for His divine Love and show our love for Him through our deeds, our actions, and loving those whom He loves.

- All Showdown competitors must meet the following requirements: be a member of a
  university/collegiate MSA registered with LSC and 18 years or older. Only current
  students or alumni who graduated in Fall 2021 or onwards can compete. Alumni that
  have graduated before Fall 2021 can attend, but not compete, at Showdown.
- LSC reserves the right to disqualify or eject any Showdown attendee for inappropriate behavior or suspicion of dishonesty.
- LSC reserves the right to make any changes to the stated rules and regulations, as deemed necessary.
- Plagiarized submissions for competitions are an automatic disqualification. Each competition entry/submission must be unique.
- Any participant who enters a competition late is subject to disqualification at the discretion of the competition's judge(s).
- Participants must be wearing their Showdown wristbands at all times and will not be allowed to enter event areas without their wristband.
- Dress code for both brothers and sisters should be **loose fitting and not transparent**. Feel free to wear your school's MSA shirt if available.
- Schools may under NO circumstances use or bring any of the following materials:
  - Decorative items or spirit gear that will leave a mess behind (i.e. glitter, smoke bombs, etc.)
  - o Items that produce amplified sounds (blow horns, megaphones, etc.)
  - o Instruments of any kind (cow bells, drums, etc.)
  - We strongly recommend that your school print and bring at least one copy of this
    packet. It is your responsibility to check the LSC website for the most up to date
    versions of this packet.

### Hilton University of Houston on Campus Hotel

This year, the MSA Lone Star Council has contracted with <u>UH Hilton</u>, which is located on campus, right in front of the Student Center. There will ONLY be 50 Double Queen rooms for a discounted rate of \$189. These 50 rooms have two Queen beds that can take 4 students, and the reservations are on a first-come, first-serve basis. 


# **Important Maps**

### Campus Map




#### Non Sport Competition Map

# **Transportation**

### **Houston METRORail**

Houston Metro has two stops on campus: UH Athletics & **UH South University Oaks**, which is the one closest to the Student Center and the Welcome Garage. **Passengers are not checked to pay, meaning students can and normally do <u>ride for free</u>. There are 3 Metro lines available:** 

- Purple Line (routes UH Campus to Downtown)
- Green Line (routes AWAY from UH Campus) DO NOT USE
- Red Line (South to North & North to South, starting from Downtown)

#### How to get to Downtown from the UH Campus:


Walk past the Welcome Center Garage to get to the UH South Oaks Metro stop. Get on the train that is headed right and has "THEATER DISTRICT" on its screen. Get off at the "CENTRAL STATION", stop at CAPITOL Street, and walk to your hotel.

#### How to get to the UH Campus from Downtown:

Walk from your hotel to "CENTRAL STATION" on Rusk Street. Make sure to get on the Purple Line Train that has "PALM CENTER" on its screen. Get off at the "UH SOUTH OAKS" stop and walk to the Student Center.



## **Parking**

The Steering Committee has negotiated with the University of Houston to get a discounted price for student parking passes at \$10 per day. The passes will be purchased upon arrival to the garage. Once you purchase the discounted parking pass, you will be able to park in the Parking Lot (4801 Calhoun Rd, Houston, TX 77004) behind the Student Center, as marked in the map below. Although all of the hotel options have paid parking, students can leave their car on campus and take the MetroRAIL back to their hotel. More parking information will be available soon.

# Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do I register through my MSA or do I register myself?

Registration is done <u>individually</u>. Some MSAs may have a form that you're required to fill out
so that they can plan lodging & transportation; however, you must still <u>register yourself with</u>
<u>us</u> in order to be considered fully registered for Showdown.

Q: I have an exam that weekend so I can't go. Can I leave Showdown early?

- Yes, you don't have to stay for the entire weekend! While we recommend staying for the
  entirety of Showdown to gain the full experience, we understand that everyone's
  circumstances are different. If you need to leave early, let your MSA President/Showdown
  Coordinator know.
  - If you're participating in a prejudged competition like Written Poetry or Short Film, and aren't able to physically attend Showdown, that's okay! You'll still need to register in order for your piece to be entered and judged in the competition.

Q: I can't come to Friday of Showdown. Is there a way I can still check-in and attend?

• Yes! email <a href="mailto:exec@msa-texas.org">exec@msa-texas.org</a> with any concerns and we'll try to figure out a way you can attend showdown.

Q: This is the first time our MSA is going to Showdown. Can someone help us keep track of what to do?

Absolutely! Please check page 6 of this document for a list of all the documents and forms
needed to be done before attending Showdown. Also, please reach out to us via email
(exec@msa-texas.org) and our Outreach Directors will follow up with you.

Q: I have a lot of questions about Showdown. Who can I talk to?

Q: My school doesn't have an MSA but I still want to compete/attend Showdown. Is this possible?

ABSOLUTELY! On the registration form, be sure to specify your school under "Other". If your school doesn't have an MSA and you'd like to compete in something, contact <a href="mailto:exec@msa-texas.org">exec@msa-texas.org</a>, so that we can try to accommodate your request(s).

#### Q: How can my MSA afford hotel & transportation costs for our members?

We recommend asking your university's student government for funding, doing fundraisers
on campus (bake sales, profit shares, etc.), and asking for donations at the masjid.
 Additionally, LSC does provide MSAs with grant funding, with certain requirements in place.

#### Q: What is required for sports jerseys?

All jerseys must be the same color as their team. Numbers must be printed on the back.
Names are not required but are encouraged. Jerseys do not need to be fancy or expensive;
simple jerseys available at Academy or Wal-Mart suffice. Additionally, jersey designs can be
handmade, with the numbers printed on the back of each jersey in bold/fabric paint. Tape is
not allowed.
